



EUROPEAN POSSE RIDE SAFETY RULES



Because we want everybody to ride in a safely manner, we would like to ask you to take the following safety rules and precautions into account:

- *We always drive in "brick" formation, this means, the first rider on the right, the second rider on the left, and so on!*
- *Make sure you wear a helmet which is legally authorized in Europe. The ECE 22.05 rating is the most widespread helmet standard internationally, required by over 50 countries worldwide (especially Europe). If you should have a police inspection on the road and you don't have a legally authorized helmet, the police will stop you from riding any further and you will need to find a new helmet!!!!.*
- *Do not forget to bring :*
 - *a valid driver's license*
 - *your original ID card , VISA, Passport as concerned*
 - *Insurance papers of your own bike !*
- *At the hotels, parking spaces are foreseen for the bikes. Everyone has to park his bike on this parking space. We have tried to arrange for as safe parking places as possible.*
- *Please make sure you can lock your bike. Bring chains or other safety locks with you. The organization is not responsible for thefts or damages!*
- *No need to tell you that you don't drink alcohol when you drive. It is your responsibility to drive safely and not to put other participants in danger. Please not that we will have to forbid you to keep on riding with the group if you have been drinking or riding dangerously.*
- *When we have a fuel stop, it is important that everyone fuels up, even if your tank is not empty. You should always take fuel together with the rest of your group. We don't stop with the group if you are suddenly out of fuel because of not fuelling up with the rest of the participants.*
- *We always start in the morning with a full tank!!
Make sure you take fuel in the evening before parking your bike at the hotel!
We will fuel up with the whole group in the evening if possible.*
- *We will have First Aid kits available, but please take your personal medication with you. The kits are only for small injuries.*
- *In Europe, it's required to have a fluo/yellow jacket with you when you drive. It's mandatory for the driver and also for the passenger.*
